

Courses of Study available for women at Christ College

Learning more about God and the Bible is not just for pastors and people in full-time ministry positions. You may be an at-home mum, a working wife, a women's ministry worker, a student, a retiree. Your life is already busy and full, but you long to learn more about God and his word so that you can better serve him where you are now.

There are many different ways for women to study the Bible and become more equipped to serve God. These include full-time, part-time, evening classes, online classes, intensive courses, and a mixture of one or more.

Christ College offers many flexible options for study at different levels. Some courses require previous tertiary study or the HSC while others have no previous academic requisites. While the minimum requirement for study is one semester, courses may be taken at many levels, including diploma, degree or postgraduate studies. It is always possible to audit courses, for which there are no assessment requirements.
