Verse 37 to forgive

“Apoluo” – leaving something behind in order to go to another place.

Definition of “to forgive”

“Set free an offender from the obligation to suffer ) particularly in our personal relationship) from the consequences of their actions.” In other words, “treat the person who has hurt you as if they never had.”
